## Clothes and Kit List

From September 2017

Items in CAPITALS must be purchased from Knighton House School.

The school uniform shop (for both new and second hand uniform) is located in the Boarding House at Knighton House School. The shop is open at the beginning of every term when the boarders return from 4.30 – 6.00.

On a Monday morning between 8.15 and 8.45 the shop will be manned by one of our Friends of Knighton House (FoKH) volunteers. Alternatively, appointments can be made with our Day Matron either by telephone 01258 480081 or email: [matrons@knightonhouse.co.uk](mailto:matrons@knightonhouse.co.uk)

Order forms can be found on Parents' Portal or on the slab (near the main stairs in the prep school). After completion they must be returned to our Day Matron via the front office. Orders will be ready for collection from the slab every Wednesday.

Uniform purchases will be put on the school bill unless it is preferable to pay by cheque or transfer.

Outgrown uniform can be donated to the shop and proceeds from sales go to FoKH for the benefit of the school and the pupils.

Notes:

**All items must be named clearly (including socks and underwear).**

Please sew nametapes securely on centre back whenever possible.

Please sew nametapes lengthwise in socks.

Extra name tapes should be sent in the suitcase for new purchases which may require naming.

**All clothing worn at school should be of neat and tidy appearance.**

**Hair** should be kept neat and tidy at all times. If it is long enough, it should be tied back. Hair bands and ties should be of a suitable colour to match the uniform – red or tortoiseshell.

**No jewellery is permitted.** Watches must be clearly marked or engraved. It is preferable, for safety reasons, that girls do not have their ears pierced. If they do, only small gold or silver studs may be worn and removed for P.E. and sport.

Please **do not bring** aerosols or razors of any kind

The Tuck Shop is open at certain times of the week, please **do not bring** extra tuck. No food is allowed to be kept in the dormitories.

- 1 GREY CLOAK (loaned by the school, £30 deposit required)
- 3 LEMON COTTON POLO SHIRTS WITH KH LOGO
- 2 GREY SWEATSHIRTS WITH KH LOGO
- 1 RED REVERSIBLE FLEECE / WATERPROOF JACKET
- 1 Pair black leather (not suede) shoes with laces, bar and buckle or Velcro fastening or loafers. No pumps. Heels no higher than 2 cm.
- 1 RED SUN CAP (summer term)
- 1 RED FLEECE GLOVES SCARF & HAT (autumn/spring terms)
- 5 Pairs long grey socks/grey woolly tights (autumn/spring terms)
- 5 Pairs short grey socks (summer term)

- 1 Grey knee length box pleat skirt – available from M&S ‘Traditional Pleated Skirt, with Triple action Stormwear™’ Product Code T760117 (Black opaque tights may be worn with the grey skirt)

- 2 RED DUNGAREES  
(Any girl in A1 who would prefer to wear the grey knee length box pleat skirt above, may do so)

Girls in B3 & B2 (Years 3 & 4) may choose to wear red opaque tights with Best Uniform.
